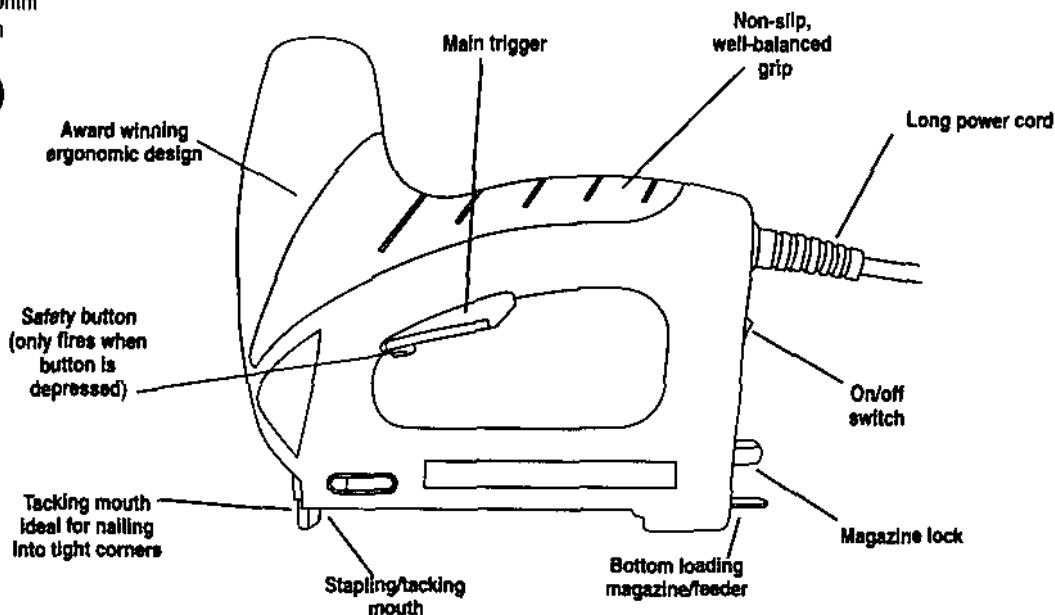

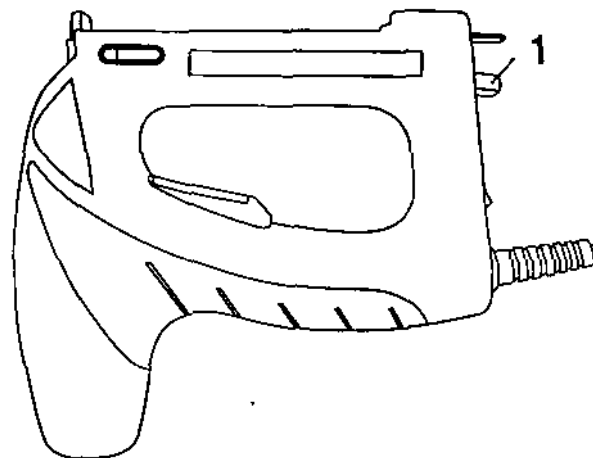


### PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

- Input Voltage : 230 Volts 50 Hz
- Max. Length of staple : Up to 14mm long (fires five lengths)
- Length of nail : 15mm long only
- Nail/Staple Type (IMPORTANT) : Use Tacwise 140 Type Staples and Nails Type 180 only

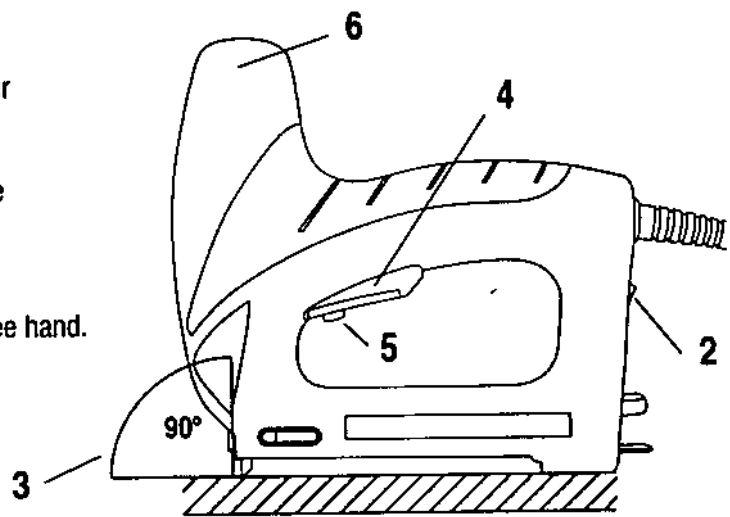
### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Step one: Loading your 140EL Pro Staple Tacker /Nailer
1. Unplug from power source.
  2. Only use Tacwise 140 Type Staples and Nails Type 180.
  3. Hold tool upside down, squeeze latch (1) and slide base open.
  4. Drop staples in channel, legs facing upwards and close base. Or drop nails in left side of channel with "T" head sitting on the nail slot. Close base while making sure nail strips stay upright in channel.
  5. Make sure that the latch is securely locked.



## Step two: How to use 140EL Pro Staple Tacker /Nailer

1. Plug tool into 230 volt, 50 Hz power outlet.
2. Turn the tool on at the on/off switch.
3. Make sure tool is firmly placed against workpiece at a 90° angle.
4. Depress main trigger and then activate tool by depressing safety button (5).
6. On hard surfaces press down on housing with free hand.
7. On soft surfaces use light pressure to prevent deep penetration.



## CLEARING A JAMMED STAPLE/NAIL

In the unlikely event of the tool jamming:-

1. Turn the tool off at the on/off switch and disconnect from power outlet and remove all staples/nails from magazine.
2. Inspect the tacker mouth end of the magazine chamber for a jammed staple/nail.
3. Remove jammed staples/nails then reload with new staples/nails.

## SAFETY

- Always wear safety goggles.
- Ensure tool is turned off at the on/off switch when not in use.
- Do not wear loose clothing or jewellery.
- Never operate near flammable liquids or explosive atmospheres.
- Do not operate machinery when tired.
- Keep children away.
- Never expose tool to rain.
- Store tool in dry, secure place.
- Never carry tool by cord or yank to disconnect from power outlet.
- Do not alter or misuse tool.

**WARNING:** Not suitable for nailing / stapling into concrete, masonry, bricks or steel. DO NOT fire if staples / nails are jammed, as this will cause damage to the driver blade. Ensure tool is turned off at the on/off switch when not in use. Keep fingers off trigger until ready to drive staple / nail.

### STANDARD WARRANTY

Tacwise provides 12 months cover.

In the event of this product breaking down the most economical option will likely be a replacement service exchange unit supplied by Tacwise.

The warranty on such consumable components (for example drive blade, feeder spring) is 6 months from date of purchase assuming normal wear and tear.
