

Schmincke AERO COLOR® Professional LINER:

6 empty pens can be filled with 36 coloured shades of AERO COLOR® Professional

Four different **AERO COLOR® Professional LINER** already allow the fast and easy application of the 36 lightfast and water proof colour shades of **AERO COLOR® Professional** without using an airbrush. Now there are two further models available.

The empty pens are available in different sizes and different tips. This allows to create easily individual sketches, drawings or signatures on diverse surfaces such as paper, canvas, wood, primed metal or primed plastic.

The coloured shades can be mixed with each other, so that the artist only needs some basic colours in order to obtain a wide and colourful selection

How to fill the AERO COLOR® Professional LINER:

- Open and remove the cap and the valve cap.
- Remove the coloured valve (LINER No. 1: yellow; LINER No. 2 + No. 4: white-violet; LINER No. 3 + No. 5: green-violet, LINER No. 6: transparent).
- Fill the **AERO COLOR® Professional** shade up to a maximum of 2/3 by using an eyedropper.
- Then put the valve back in place, screw the valve cap and the cap tightly.
- After reassembling and closing, shake the LINER well.
- Shake well the reassembled and closed LINER and press the tip (gently and with caution) until the colour appears in the tip!

Further useful advice:

- When starting, it is advisable to go ahead with caution when exchanging the tips. We recommend you to protect the workplace and to wear protective gloves as **AERO COLOR® Professional** dries water-resistant!
- Store the tank of the LINER – when dismantled – upright in a jar in order to avoid that the colour or the 2 mixing balls spill out of the LINER.
- Activate the refilled LINER on a separate paper - not on your artwork.
- The label of the LINER shows a small blank frame where you can note the colour numer.
- Individual colours should be mixed *before* filling into the LINER. For a summary of RAL® colours pls. refer to www.aerocolor.de
- Adding about 5 % of AERO Retarder (50 607) slows drying of acrylic colours and improves the flow properties
- Put the cap on the LINER directly after use in order to avoid the drying of **AERO COLOR® Professional** in the LINER tip! Store the LINER horizontally.
- Protect from frost!

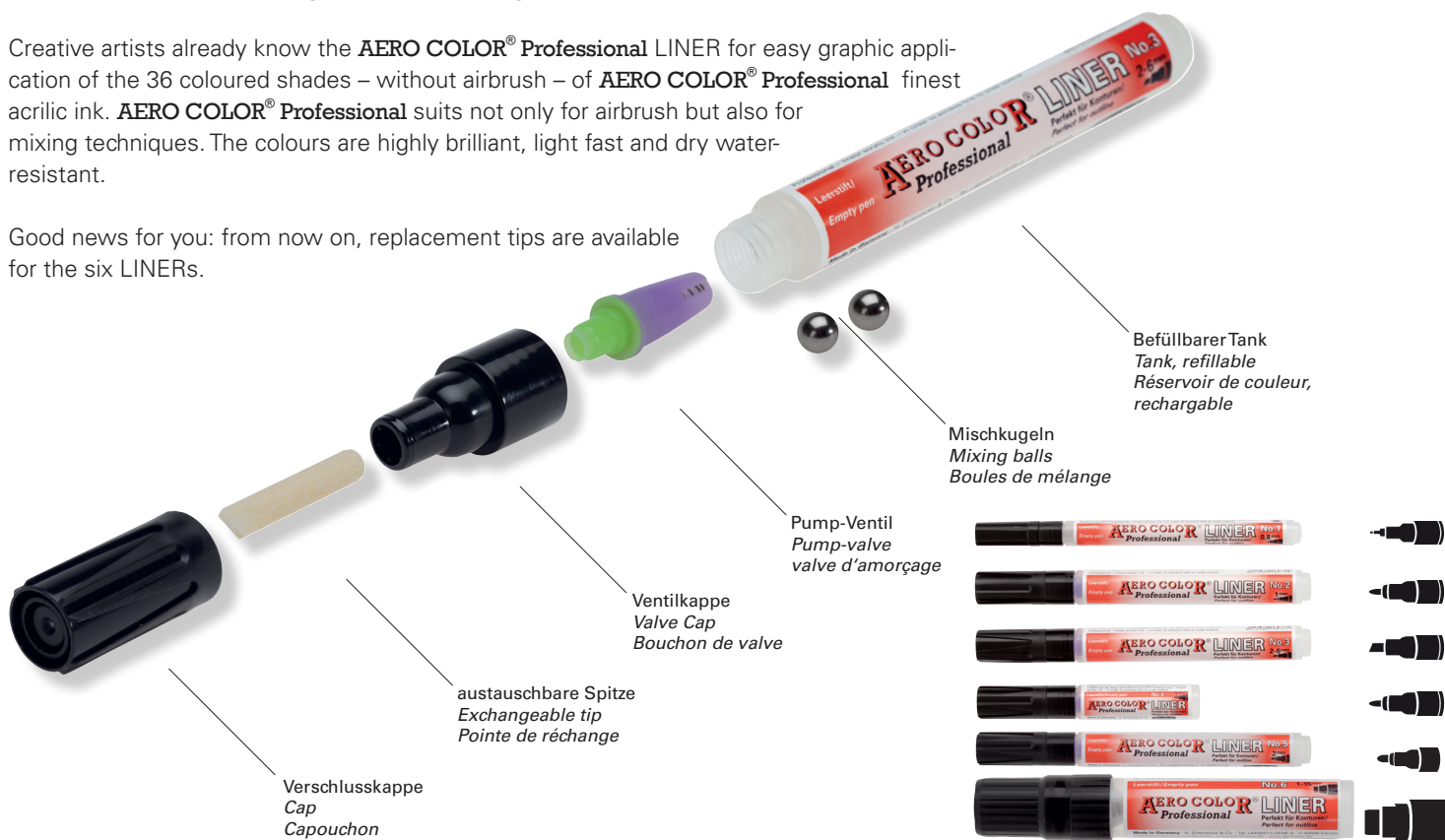

Now available: Replacement tips for six AERO COLOR® Professional LINER!

Creative artists already know the **AERO COLOR® Professional LINER** for easy graphic application of the 36 coloured shades – without airbrush – of **AERO COLOR® Professional** finest acrylic ink. **AERO COLOR® Professional** suits not only for airbrush but also for mixing techniques. The colours are highly brilliant, light fast and dry water-resistant.

Good news for you: from now on, replacement tips are available for the six LINERs.



How to change the tips of the AERO COLOR® Professional LINER:

LINER No. 1, No. 3 and No. 5:

- Unscrew LINER cap including valve cap with caution.
- Hold the valve of the LINER and withdraw the tip in forward direction.
- Assemble the new tip.
- Afterwards reassemble the valve cap and the LINER cap and screw it tightly.

LINER No. 2, No. 4 and No. 6:

- Take off the LINER cap.
- Unscrew the valve cap with caution.
- Press the tip incl. the cellular foam out of the valve cap (be careful, both is soaked with colour).
- Reassemble the new tip and the cellular foam, then insert the tip (in forward direction) into the valve cap.
- Afterwards reassemble the valve cap and the LINER cap.

Please note for all kind of LINER:

- Shake well the reassembled and closed LINER and press the tip (gently and with caution) until the colour appears in the tip – done!

Further useful advice:

- When starting, it is advisable to go ahead with caution when exchanging the tips. We recommend you to protect the workplace and to wear protective gloves as **AERO COLOR® Professional** dries water-resistant!
- Store the tank of the LINER – when dismantled – upright in a jar in order to avoid that the colour or the 2 mixing balls spill out of the LINER.
- Activate the refilled LINER on a separate paper - not on your artwork.
